### Science

It is still so hard for me to believe that we are 5 days into December! The whirlwind between Thanksgiving and Christmas is really something. ### Writing/Reading

### Math

We have officially finished the lessons for multiplication and division. Any extra work that you can do with your child over the next 5 days will be amazing in preparation for our unit test on Thursday the 11<sup>th</sup>. Please keep having your child work on his/her multiplication facts. Continued practice helps solidify it to our long-term memory.

Next week, students will begin to study Geometry. Geometry is a fun unit, with a great deal of vocabulary. We will do the first 4-5 lessons before Christmas and then finish it up after we return.

We have been working on Waves of Sound. It has been interesting to learn how sound waves move, and just what kind of damage can be done when those sound waves become large!
