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**Math:** The class successfully made it to the middle of Mission 3 in Math this week. We are starting Lesson 20 on Monday. We just started the division section of this module, and although it is difficult, the students are working so hard and taking it step by step. This Mission teaches students the lifelong skills of multiplying and dividing big numbers. Students learn strategies that will allow them to multiply and divide on paper and in their heads. **At home, please be practicing multiplication facts.** I have noticed that we all need a little practice multiplying a number by 6, 7, and 8. This will benefit your child as they work through this long unit!

**Science:** We are learning about the Human Body in Science this week. On Monday, we made Robotic Fingers and that was a HIT! The students absolutely loved the experiment... they wanted to make an entire hand! We are finishing this unit next week, I am so proud of them!

**Social Studies:** We are on a break! Switched over to Science for 2 weeks!

**Language Arts:** This week in Wonders, we finished up our Opinion Essays. The students were able to write down and brainstorm, but then they switched over to their computers to type! They loved it. We started Drama towards the end of the week and learned how complex this genre really is.
